Trucking Tycoon Helps Fund Peace Program

Rotarian Al Jubitz remembers the time when he was 12 years old and another boy punched him in the face. His ego was bruised, but he learned a lesson: Peace is always better than fighting.

Now he hopes to see that lesson applied on a global scale. A member of the Rotary Club of Portland, Oregon, USA, Jubitz has pledged US\$300,000 to fund five Rotary World Peace Fellowships for aspiring peacemakers as they pursue master’s degrees.

Through the Jubitz Family Foundation, he and his daughters have also awarded grants to Portland State University’s conflict resolution graduate program, the Wholistic Peace Institute, and the Oregon Peace Institute, which Jubitz chaired in the 1970s.

Our two outbound teams, one to Argentina and the other to So. Korea, have left on their journeys. This week the two inbound teams arrive. All four teams will be at the District Conference in Pendleton April 26th to delight us with their experiences.



Kenny is Choice for 2009-10 RI President

John Kenny, of the Rotary Club of Grangemouth, Central, Scotland, is the selection of the Nominating Committee for President of Rotary International in 2009-10.

He will become the president-nominee on December 1st if there are no challenging candidates. A Rotarian since 1970, Kenny served Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland as president and vice president. He has served RI as director, executive committee chair, Rotary Foundation trustee, institute moderator, district governor, convention vice chair and group leader, president's representative, and committee member and chair. He's been a delegate, member at large, and parliamentarian at several Councils on Legislation.

- Lake Oswego Club – They now have nearly 100 active Paul Harris Fellows and the highest number of Paul Harris Society members of any club in the District (PHS = \$1000/yr to the Rotary Foundation). More great news – this club has agreed to donate all the net proceeds from their highly successful Lobster and Crab event to Polio Plus!
- New Interact Club – The Vancouver Sunrise club is sponsoring a club in the new Union H.S. in east Vancouver. Recently about 20 interactors received their charter from Rotary International. We now have 17 active clubs.
- Programs – I was able to hear two very good programs in my recent travels: Dick Pine, publicist with OMSI, and Rotarian James Hodges, who does an excellent impersonation of George Washington, emphasizing Washington's leadership.
