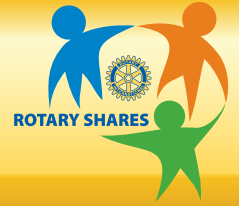

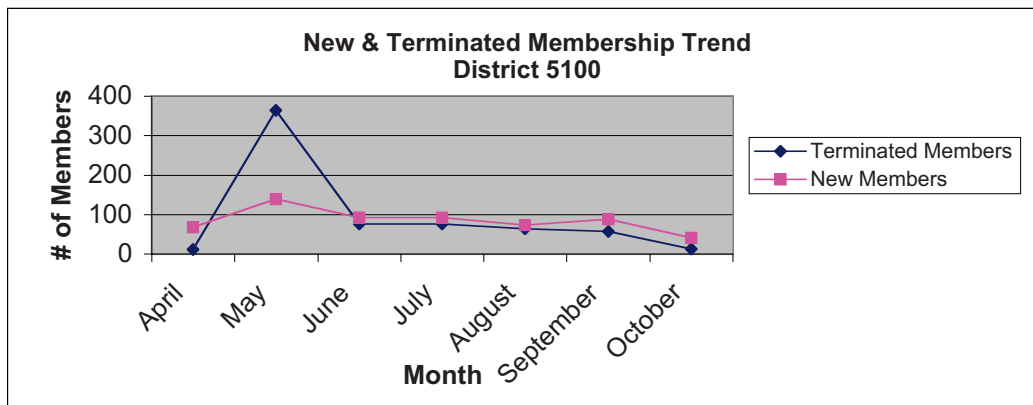
District Office Moves

Open House Week Dec. 10-14

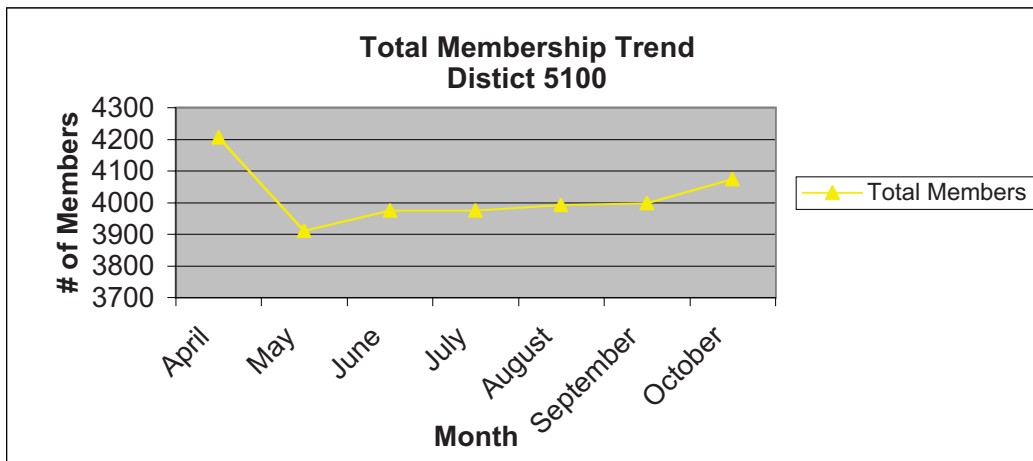

POLIO GRANT FROM THE GATES FOUNDATION

Today, Nov. 26th, is a historic day for Rotary. The Gates Foundation has awarded TRF a challenge grant of \$100 million which Rotary will match, dollar for dollar, over three years. This will provide \$200 million in support of our top goal of a polio-free world. This is the largest single grant ever given to a volunteer service organization and represents a tremendous validation of the approach and success of our PolioPlus program.
